



Special Call for Proposals British Council's 60th anniversary in Canada Grant support for research trip to Québec 2020

CONTEXT AND OBJECTIVES

For the occasion of the British Council's 60th anniversary in Canada, British Council and the Gouvernement du Québec wish to support travel costs for research trips in the cultural sector.

This special call for proposals aims to:

- Encourage new cultural exchanges between the two societies through the mutual cultural presence of each entity in the other's territory;
- Further the development of new partnerships between Québec and British cultural organizations;
- Deepen and reinforce relationships between Québec and British partners;
- Foster better mutual knowledge through network consolidation and the promotion of cultural expertise.

PROJECT ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for grant support, the research trip must:

- > Target at one Québec partner:
- Foster the development of mid- and long-term exchanges between Québec and the UK:
- Enable partners to establish new collaborations, develop new relationships, or deepen networks of creation, dissemination and marketing of cultural products/ services or facilitate access to them;
- Encourage the development of special skills in the cultural field;
- > Start as early as January 1st, 2020 and end by December 31st, 2020;
- Complete and submit the application form by the deadline Friday September 20, 2019 at 11:59pm EST.

This special 60th anniversary call for proposals is intended to provide financial support for a research trip to Québec for up to a maximum of \$2,500 CAD. This lump sum is to be used to support the purchase of economy round-trip airfare, accommodation, meals and local travel expenses.

Due to the special nature of this call for proposals, proposals submitted by British individuals or organizations do not need to have a Québec partner submit a joint proposal to the Gouvernement du Québec.

Please note that the regular biannual call for projects between Québec and the British Council will be launched in the **spring of 2020**.
